

**MINUTES OF A REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING  
DECEMBER 18, 2006**

A Regular Council Meeting was held at 5:30 P. M. in the council chambers of City Hall. Present for the meeting were Mayor Reuben Shelley, Council Members John Glover, Ray Marler, Steve Watson, Benton Beasley and Mary Williams. .

Ray Marler made a motion to approve an invoice for SARCOA in the amount of \$1056.90, Mary Williams seconded the motion and all members voted in the affirmative.

Mayor Shelley informed everyone that City Hall would be closed Monday December 25<sup>th</sup> and Tuesday December 26<sup>th</sup> for Christmas holidays and Monday January 1<sup>st</sup> for New Years Eve.

Mayor Shelley informed the Council that the January 1<sup>st</sup> meeting would be rescheduled until January 8<sup>th</sup> due to the New Years holiday.

Council was informed by Mayor Shelley there would be a called Council Meeting and Public Hearing on December 29<sup>th</sup> at 8:00 am for some re-zoning issues.

Danny Vinson, Water/Wastewater Superintendent gave a monthly report for his department.

Police Chief, Mark Jones gave a monthly report for his department.

Council Member Benton Beasley requested that the City have Alabama Power put a street light on Log Lane near the home of Craig Childrey. A motion was made by Benton Beasley to have the light installed, Steve Watson seconded and all members voted in the affirmative.
