

MINUTES OF A REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING
January 22, 2007

A Regular Council Meeting was held at 5:30 P. M. in the council chambers of City Hall. Present for the meeting were Mayor Reuben Shelley, Council Members John Glover, Ray Marler, Steve Watson, Benton Beasley and Mary Williams. .

- Install pump at North Lift Station
- Sewer line extension on Whitten St
- Southern Linc for WWater Dept

Prices on the equipment and projects will be presented to the Council at a later date.

Benton Beasley made a motion for the purchase of a Southern Linc phone for the Wastewater Department, Mary Williams seconded and all members voted in the affirmative.

In a written request from Librarian Dede Coe, she asked permission to advertise for a part time employee to replace Areal Crozier. Mayor Shelley will talk with Dede about the advertisement.

Council Comments:

Steve Watson asked that several line items on the November 2006 Financial Statement be reviewed for accuracy.

Ray Marler informed the Council that the 2006-2007 budget needed some amendments. The Fire Department had several expense accounts that had no budget.
