

**MINUTES OF A REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING
MARCH 5, 2007**

A Regular Council Meeting was held at 5:30 P. M. in the council chambers of City Hall. Present for the meeting were Mayor Reuben Shelley, Council Members John Glover, Ray Marler, Steve Watson, Benton Beasley and Mary Williams.

The mayor asked everyone to stand for the Pledge of Allegiance and Benton Beasley offered prayer.

Steve Watson made a motion to approve the minutes from the February 19th meeting, Ray Marler seconded and all members voted in the affirmative.

A motion was made by Steve Watson to approve the Cities bills, Mary Williams seconded and all members voted in the affirmative.

Steve Watson made a motion to accept Resolution 4-2007 for a FY 2006 CDBG Economic Development Infrastructure grant, John Glover seconded and all members voted in the affirmative.

Librarian, Dede Coe gave the February 2007 report for the Library. Mrs. Coe also presented to the Council, a Parks and Recreation Department project that she has been working on.

Police Chief, Mark Jones gave his departments report for the month of February 2007.

Fire Chief, Eric Lawrence gave the Fire Departments report for the month of February 2007. Eric advised the Council that the Fire Department could not wait on the purchase of a generator and would go ahead and make the purchase.

City Clerks, Susan Money presented the Mayor and Council the following handouts:

1. A letter requesting an increase in job responsibility and pay for Wanda Floyd.
2. A handout about "Working with Municipal Boards" and the responsibility for those boards to comply with the Open Meeting Laws.
3. Amendments that need to be made to the 2006-2007 Budget.

Council Comments:

Mayor Shelley informed Mrs. Williams that he had a meeting with the Recreation Board following the council meeting to discuss the letter.
