

MINUTES OF A REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING
APRIL 2, 2007

A Regular Council Meeting was held at 5:30 P. M. in the council chambers of City Hall. Present for the meeting were Mayor Reuben Shelley, Council Members John Glover, Ray Marler, Steve Watson, Benton Beasley and Mary Williams.

The mayor asked everyone to stand for the Pledge of Allegiance and John Glover offered prayer.

Ray Marler made a motion to accept Ordinance 3-2007 regulating the riding of bicycles, etc. on sidewalks and other City property, Mary Williams seconded and all members voted in the affirmative.

Ray Marler made a motion to approve the minutes from the March 19th, 21st, 23rd, and 28th meetings, John Glover seconded and all members voted in the affirmative.

A motion was made by Ray Marler to approve the Cities bills, John Glover seconded and all members voted in the affirmative.

A bid to fix the air conditioner at the Senior Center was tabled until another bid could be received.

Mayor Shelley informed the Council that five windows on the front part of the old section of City Hall needed to be replaced. Crews Construction is going to add \$2,500.00 to his current invoice for the windows and the installation

Benton Beasley made a motion to rescind the decision to allow Joe Jolly and Co. to restructure the Cities Bonds, Steve Watson seconded and all members voted in the affirmative.

Ray Marler made a motion to accept Headland National Banks bid for a Bank Loan excluding \$175,000.00 and Mary Williams seconded. Mayor Shelley, nay vote; John Glover, nay vote; Ray Marler, yea vote; Steve Watson, nay vote; Benton Beasley, yea vote; and Mary Williams, yea vote. Motion died due to a tie vote.

Ray Marler made a motion to reappoint Grady McDaniel to the Board of Adjustments, Mary Williams seconded and all members voted in the affirmative.

Ray Marler made a motion to replace Glovers McKay with Cameron Odom on the Board of Adjustments, Mary Williams seconded and all members voted in the affirmative.

Mary Williams made a motion to reappoint A. B. Cotton and John Glover to the Planning Commission, Ray Marler seconded and all members voted in the affirmative.

Ray Marler made a motion to replace Gary Smith with Tim McCraney, Steve Gates with Michael Hartzog, and appointed Jason Singletary to the Planning Commission, Steve Watson seconded and all members voted in the affirmative.

Steve Watson made a motion to reinstate the \$100.00 inspection fees for all new construction, John Glover seconded and all members voted in the affirmative.

Librarian, Dede Coe gave the March 2007 report for the Library.

Police Chief, Mark Jones gave his departments report for the month of March 2007 and activities for 2004 - 2006.

John Hewitt with the Zoning Board updated the Council on the April 3rd Zoning Meeting.

Public Comments:

Mrs. Diane Hinson addressed the Mayor and Council about Naomi Street needing to be re-paved and the water quality at her Flower Shop on Main Street.

Two residents from Huntington Place were present to ask questions about the subdivision codes and problems they were having with their homes.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 7:05 P.M. on a motion by Ray Marler.
