

**MINUTES OF A REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING
JUNE 18, 2007**

A Regular Council Meeting was held at 5:30 P. M. in the council chambers of City Hall. Present for the meeting were Mayor Reuben Shelley, Council Members John Glover, Ray Marler, and Benton Beasley. Mary Williams and Steve Watson were absent.

The mayor asked everyone to stand for the Pledge of Allegiance and John Glover offered prayer.

Ray Marler made a motion to approve the minutes from the June 11th meeting, Benton Beasley seconded and all members voted in the affirmative.

Benton Beasley made a motion to pay the bills, Ray Marler seconded and all members voted in the affirmative.

Benton Beasley made a motion to accept Ordinance 5-2007 implementing a deferred prosecution program through the Cities Municipal Court, Ray Marler seconded and all members voted in the affirmative.

John Glover made a motion to suspend the rules for the reading of Ordinance 6-2007 and Benton Beasley seconded the motion. John Glover, yea vote; Ray Marler, yea vote; and Benton Beasley, yea vote. Benton Beasley made a motion to accept Ordinance 6-2007 borrowing \$75,000.00 for water lines to the Helms Property on 134 West, John Glover seconded and all members voted in the affirmative.

Benton Beasley made a motion to approve City Clerk, Susan Money to attend the fall Clerk's Training in Tuscaloosa August 8th – 10th and the Clerk's Meeting in Orange Beach November 28th – 30th, Ray Marler seconded and all members voted in the affirmative.

Water/Wastewater Superintendent, Jason Singletary gave an update from June 11th (first day the water pump on Main Street went down) through June 18th. To date the pump has not been fixed but his report outlined the activities for the week. Jason also, presented the Council with future updates needed at the Water Wells and Tanks.

Street/Sanitation/Animal Control Superintendent, George Trotter gave a report for his department covering the months of October 2006 through June 15, 2007.

Fire Chief, Eric Lawrence gave his departments report for May 2007. He informed the Council he had been in contact with other surrounding Communities about a "Drop Tank System" that could be used while the water pump is down. If needed these Communities could provide this service for Headland.

Council Comments:

Councilmen, Ray Marler asked Terry Grimes to stress the water situation in his report for the Abbeville Herald. Marler requested that an ordinance be drawn up with penalties for those who were not abiding by the request not to use sprinkler systems at this time.

Public Comments:

Mrs. Andrea Shiphorst requested that the procedures for Animal control be put in the newspaper for public notification. Also, requested a speeding sign be put up in Willow Oakes and that some type of penalty be implemented for watering when there were water restrictions in place.

Mrs. Donna Medina requested that the Council look into the benefits of a recycling program and that the City needs to inform the Citizens when there is a case of rabies discovered.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 6:35 P.M. on a motion by Ray Marler.
