

**MINUTES OF A SPECIAL CALLED COUNCIL MEETING
SEPTEMBER 24, 2007**

A Special Called Council Meeting was held at 6:30 P. M. in the council chambers of City Hall. Present for the meeting were Mayor Reuben Shelley, Council members John Glover, Ray Marler, Steve Watson, Benton Beasley, and Mary Williams.

Benton Beasley made a motion to approve a variance for Steve Thompson at 600 Holly Lane, Mary Williams seconded and all members voted in the affirmative.

Benton Beasley made a motion to approve an Exception for Williams & Sons Sportswear at 500 E Church Street, Mary Williams seconded and all members voted in the affirmative.

Steve Watson made a motion to allow Mayor Shelley to sign paper work from Polyengineering for the Water Well Project, John Glover seconded and all members voted in the affirmative.

Mary Williams made a motion to approve the Bad Debt Write Off's for the Water Department, Benton Beasley seconded and all members voted in the affirmative.

The RVS Software for the Water Department was tabled.

Ray Marler made a motion to approve the one-time retiree longevity bonus, John Glover seconded and all members voted in the affirmative.

Water/Wastewater Superintendent, Jason Singletary informed the Council that in the past two (2) weeks there have been two (2) Wastewater pumps go down at the Walden Pond lift station. Mr. Singletary asked the Council to approve a replacement pump at \$3,527.00.

Steve Watson made the motion to approve the purchase of the replacement pump, John Glover seconded and all members voted in the affirmative.

Mr. Singletary requested that the revenue generated from the tower rental on the water tanks be deposited into the Reserves Account in order to pay for future painting projects on the tanks.

Benton Beasley made a motion for the EMS Department to upgrade the Life Pac's to be purchased in the 2007-2008 budget, Ray Marler seconded and all members voted in the affirmative.
