

**MINUTES OF A REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING  
MAY 11, 2009**

A Regular Council Meeting was held at 6:00 p.m. in the council chambers of City Hall. Present for the meeting were Mayor Ray Marler, Council Members John Mellown, Benton Beasley, and Kendrick Spurling. Councilmen John Glover and Jody Singleton were absent.

Mayor Marler called the meeting to order and asked everyone to stand for the Pledge of Allegiance. Councilman Beasley offered prayer.

Benton Beasley made a motion to approve the minutes from the April 21st meeting, Kendrick Spurling seconded and all members voted in the affirmative.

Kendrick Spurling made a motion to approve payment of the bills, John Mellown seconded and all members voted in the affirmative.

Four companies submitted bids for a new roof on the old section of City Hall. One company submitted an additional bid for a metal roof. After some discussion the Council requested additional bids on metal roofs.

The Council requested that Mayor Marler consult with the City Attorney regarding the one-time lump sum payment to Omega Rail Management.

Kendrick Spurling made a motion to approve Lewis Incorporated to perform the following:

1. Install one (1) speed break at each of the following locations: Knowles Street  
West Church Street  
Valley View
2. Repair a 160'x30' section of asphalt at Cross Creek

Benton Beasley seconded the motion and all members voted in the affirmative.

Kendrick Spurling made a motion to table the proposal from Lewis Incorporated to re-pave Railroad Street until other prices could be acquired. Benton Beasley seconded the motion and all members voted in the affirmative.

This years Relay for Life was a success and Mayor Marler thanked everyone for all of their help.
