

**MINUTES OF A REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING  
JANUARY 5, 2010**

A Regular Council Meeting was held at 6:00 p.m. in the council chambers of City Hall. Present for the meeting were Mayor Ray Marler, Council Members John Glover, Jody Singleton, John Mellown, Benton Beasley and Kendrick Spurling.

The mayor asked everyone to stand for the Pledge of Allegiance and Jody Singleton offered prayer.

Court Clerk, Crystal Gibson gave a 2009 year-end report for the Court System. Quarterly totals for October, November and December of 2009 were also submitted.

**Public Hearing**

Mayor Marler convened the public hearing at 6:10 p.m. regarding the rezoning of the following property:

Property located at 476 W King St (Bobby Campbell) rezoned from M1 to R1.

There being no public comments Jody Singleton made a motion to adjourn the public hearing at 6:12 p.m. Kendrick Spurling seconded the motion and all members voted in the affirmative.

Benton Beasley made a motion to suspend the rules for the first reading of Ordinance 1-2010 to amend the City of Headland Zoning Ordinance, John Mellown seconded and all members voted in the affirmative.

Kendrick Spurling made a motion to approve Ordinance 1-2010, Benton Beasley seconded and all members voted in the affirmative.

Jody Singleton made a motion to approve the minutes from the December 15<sup>th</sup> meeting, John Mellown seconded and all members voted in the affirmative.

Kendrick Spurling made a motion to approve payment of the City bills, John Glover seconded and all members voted in the affirmative.

No one was present to discuss the Farm Fuel bid for the Headland Airport.

**Mayors Report:**

January 18<sup>th</sup> City Hall will be closed in observance of Martin Luther King Jr. Day.

There will be a meeting with KPS regarding the Cities Comprehensive Plan on January 14<sup>th</sup> at 2:00 p.m. in City Hall.

Recently two bids for the Cities Property Insurance had been discussed in a Work Session. Mayor Marler requested that the Council vote on retaining Solomon Insurance Company (Municipal Insurance) or changing to Headland Insurance Company (Travelers Insurance).

John Glover made a motion to retain Solomon Insurance Company (Municipal Insurance), Kendrick Spurling seconded and all members voted in the affirmative.

**Department Reports:**

Street/Sanitation Superintendent, Steve Pitts was not present.

Water/Wastewater Superintendent, Jason Singletary informed the Council that the Water Department had only one issue in the month of December. A cylinoid valve on Well 3 had busted and he is running off of Well 4. This is a minor issue and easily fixed.

On the Wastewater side Highway 174 (Broad Street) is still closed due to a section of sewer line collapsing. The section has been by-passed and no residents or businesses have been affected by the problem. The asphalt will be replaced as soon as weather permits and the road re-opened.

Mr. Singletary informed the Council that he has submitted the sewer collapse to FEMA. He has a meeting in Ozark on the 13<sup>th</sup> to discuss the issue with FEMA and will know more after the meeting.
