

MINUTES OF A REGULAR COUNCIL MEETING
May 4, 2010

A Regular Council Meeting was held at 6:00 pm in the council chambers of City Hall. Present for the meeting were Mayor Ray Marler, Council Members John Glover, Jody Singleton, John Mellown, Benton Beasley and Kendrick Spurling.

The mayor asked everyone to stand for the Pledge of Allegiance and Kendrick Spurling offered prayer.

Benton Beasley made a motion to approve the April 20, 2010 minutes as written, Jody Singleton seconded and all members voted in the affirmative.

Kendrick Spurling made a motion to approve payment of the City bills, John Mellown seconded and all members voted in the affirmative.

Mrs. Marilyn Adams with Keep the Wiregrass Beautiful updated the Council on the group's inspection of the City streets. The group gave the City a (2) two, with a (1) one being the best. Mrs. Adams encouraged the Council to have two people attend their next meeting on the third Wednesday of the month at 3:00 pm.

Kendrick Spurling made a motion to change Lake Forrest Estates to Holman Drive Extension, John Mellown seconded and all members voted in the affirmative.

Kendrick Spurling made a motion to allow City Clerk, Susan Money to attend the AAMCA Summer Conference June 11th through June 12th. John Glover seconded the motion and all members voted in the affirmative.

Mayors Report:

Mayor Marler informed the Council that the EMA Community Safe Room grant and the grant for a new generator have both been sent back to the City for additional information.

Mayor Marler presented the Council with a new Classification Plan and Pay Step Plan for City Employees. The Pay Step Plan was updated to include the new minimum wage of \$7.25. After some discussion, John Glover made a motion to table the issue until more information could be acquired. Jody Singleton seconded the motion and all members voted in the affirmative.

Department Reports:

Street/Sanitation Superintendent, Steve Pitts gave the Council an update on his department. Mr. Pitts supplied the Council with estimates on four (4) tippers, new garbage carts, and financing for the project.

Water/Wastewater Superintendent, Jason Singletary gave his departments April 2010 report.

Council Comments:

Councilman Mellown informed the Council of a request from the Headland Methodist Church to become a hurricane shelter.

Councilman Mellown also had a request for either three (3) way stop signs to be installed or speed bumps on Alice Drive.

Councilman Singleton, requested Police presents on Walden Pond Drive from 3:00 until 5:00 pm due to speeding. Mr. Singleton said he had some request for speed bumps but was unsure if the entire neighborhood wanted them.

Public Comments:

Danny McKinney with Headland Renaissance requested use of the City Square on July 31, 2010 for another rummage sale.

Jim Gamble was preset concerning the price of a City Building Permit to construct a garage. Benton Beasley made a motion to give Mr. Gamble a one time building permit for \$87.50 to construct the garage. Kendrick Spurling seconded the motion and all members voted in the affirmative.

They're being no further business the meeting was adjourned at 7:00 pm on a motion by Jody Singleton.
