

COUNCIL CHAMBERS

November 4, 2014

The Council of the City of Headland was called to order in the City Hall on November 4, 2014 with the following members present: Ray Marler, Mayor; Councilmembers: James Williams, Jr., Jody Singleton, Michael Roland, Joe Falkner, and Kendrick Spurling.

Upon a motion by Singleton and a second by Roland, the Council voted as follows to approve the minutes of the previous meeting as read:

Public Comments:

Rhonda Harrison, Chamber of Commerce Director, thanked the public and the city for their participation in Halloween Scream. She also thanked the police department.
