The Council of the City of Headland was called to order in the City Hall on November 18, 2014 with the following members present: Ray Marler, Mayor; Councilmembers: Michael Roland, Joe Falkner, and Kendrick Spurling. Council members James Williams, Jr., and Jody Singleton were absent.

Interim Fire Chief, Glenn Temples, presented an adoption of the fire code. With new business coming to Headland Temples feels there is a need to implement our own codes. We are currently using the 2003 National Codes and 2009 International Codes from the state. Temples suggested that we establish requirements to enhance safety. Fire inspections would be done on current businesses and ample time would be given for the businesses to comply to the recommendations given.
