

## COUNCIL CHAMBERS

January 6, 2015

The Council of the City of Headland was called to order in the City Hall on January 6, 2015 with the following members present: Ray Marler, Mayor; Councilmembers: James Williams, Jr., Jody Singleton, Michael Roland, Joe Falkner, and Kendrick Spurling.

Upon a motion by Falkner and a second by Spurling, the Council voted as follows to approve the minutes of the previous meeting as read:

### Public Comments:

Headland Area Chamber of Commerce Director, Rhonda Harrison, invited the Mayor and Council to the Chamber Membership on Thursday, January 15<sup>th</sup> beginning at 5:30. George Wallace, Jr. will be the speaker and will have be signing his books at the banquet; Blue Plate will cater.

### Old Business:

Fire Chief, Glenn Temples, revisited the subject of adopting a Fire Code for the City of Headland.

Temples reiterated that this would be for new and existing businesses, but that they would work with existing businesses so they wouldn't have to spend a lot of money bringing their buildings up to date all at once. He confirmed these codes would be applicable to new additions to businesses as well.

Upon a motion by Roland and second by Falkner the council voted as follows to table the discussion until a thorough list of requirements can be compiled and presented for adoption:

### Mayor's Report:
