

COUNCIL CHAMBERS

February 17, 2015

TIME: 6:00PM

The Council of the City of Headland was called to order in the City Hall on February 17, 2015 with the following members present: Ray Marler, Mayor; Councilmembers: James Williams, Jr., Jody Singleton, Michael Roland, Joe Falkner, and Kendrick Spurling.

Upon a motion by Singleton and a second by Falkner, the Council voted as follows to approve the minutes of the previous meeting as read:

Motion carried unanimously.

There were no Public Comments.

Chad Hughes with Fire & Rescue requested the city sign a Mutual Aid Agreement stating the city would assist other cities if needed. He presented the mayor and Council with a breakdown of what the city had spent in previous years and stated the agreement could be done with little to no overtime.

Debbie Yurovich requested space on the square to place a peanut statue in honor of Dancing Dave on the downtown square; she also requested permission to plan a community event to dedicate the peanut. She stated the money for the peanut will come from donations from Facebook friends of a page she has already set up for him (there are 5,000 friends thus far.) The city would be responsible for the maintenance and up keep if damaged.

Ray Bickley, Planning Commission Chairman, has advised that KPS did a generic zoning plan. In the ordinance it states that there are to be no livestock in the city limits. Some areas are zoned Commercial with homes on the same street. Bickley submitted a revised ordinance and asked that the City advertise the ordinance.

Council Comments:

Singleton checked on the street light requested by Ray Walden on County Road 22. Per Alabama Power the light can be put on an existing pole and would cost approximately \$90/year. He requested approval from the council.
