

COUNCIL CHAMBERS

March 3, 2015

The Council of the City of Headland was called to order in the City Hall on March 3, 2015 with the following members present: Ray Marler, Mayor; Councilmembers: James Williams, Jr., Jody Singleton, Michael Roland, Joe Falkner, and Kendrick Spurling.
