

## COUNCIL CHAMBERS

June 23, 2015

TIME: 6:00PM

The Council of the City of Headland was called to order in the City Hall on June 23, 2015 with the following members present: Ray Marler, Mayor; Councilmembers: James Williams, Jr., Jody Singleton, Michael Roland, Joe Falkner, and Kendrick Spurling.

Upon a motion by Singleton and a second by Roland, the Council voted as follows to approve the minutes of the previous meeting as read:

### Public Comments:

Jeannie Siglar with WRMZ, Ram Radio, announced that they would like to provide the music for the 4<sup>th</sup> of July Fireworks. They plan to have signs advertising firework show attendees to tune their radios to 98.1 for a live remote synced with the fireworks.

Rhonda Harrison, Headland Area Chamber of Commerce Director, announced that Sundown Cinema was a success. She is currently looking into a fall date for the third showing.

Murray Yance, Headland Plumbing and Electric, advised the council that the Emergency Generator for E-911 will be delivered on Thursday; a forklift is needed. Mayor advised that Golden Peanut be contacted for use of a forklift and SEAGD be contacted to run the line at the pad where the generator will sit. Yance updated the council that he fixed faucets and a few lights on the square. He also requested that the bike lanes on Main Street be swept.

May Bills were presented to the council. Upon a motion by Singleton and a second by Roland the council voted as follows to approve:
