

## COUNCIL CHAMBERS

July 21, 2015

TIME: 6:00PM

The Council of the City of Headland was called to order in the City Hall on July 21, 2015 with the following members present: Ray Marler, Mayor; Councilmembers: James Williams, Jr., Jody Singleton, Michael Roland, and Joe Falkner and Kendrick Spurling.

Upon a motion by Singleton and a second by Falkner, the Council voted as follows to approve the minutes of the previous meeting as read:

Yeas – Williams, Jr., Singleton, Roland, Falkner, and Spurling

Nays – None

Motion carried unanimously.

### Public Comments:

Murray Yance with Headland Plumbing and Electric updated the council that the generator requested by E-911 had been installed and the gas line is in.

Chief Jones updated the council with the June Incident Report including 7503 calls, 176 warnings cited, 49 arrests, 17 warrants and 121 911-calls.

He also reported that they had received the funds from Doug Valeska on the \$35,000 seized and is requesting to purchase 3 vehicles (2003, 2006 & 2007 Crown Victorias) from the Abbeville Police Department with these funds. He also stated they have 3 vehicles that can be sold (2005 Crown Vic that belongs to the city, 2006 Nissan Titan and 2014 Ford Mustang which were drug seizures). Upon a motion by Singleton to add the 2005 Crown to surplus to sale and a second by Williams, Jr. the council voted as follows to approve:

Motion carried unanimously.

Upon a motion by Singleton and a second by Spurling the council voted as follows to purchase the Crown Vics from the City of Abbeville:

Motion carried unanimously.

Ronnie Dollar, Henry County EMA Director, proposed Resolution 5-2015 regarding the Hazard Mitigation Plan stating that Henry County was now eligible to receive funds for a storm shelter. Upon a motion by Singleton and a second by Williams, Jr. the council voted as follows to pass Resolution 5-2015:

Mayor Marler brought forth the ARSEA APEAL stating the city could fund a one-time lump sum of \$4,454 towards a bonus for current retirees. Council agreed to table discussion until it could be determined if the bonus was given last year.

Mayor Marler asked the council to review the June bills given to them. Singleton made a motion to approve the bills followed by a second by Falkner. The council voted as follows to approve:

### Mayor's Report:

Mayor Ray Marler congratulated the 11-12 Headland All-Stars for placing 3<sup>rd</sup> in the State Tournament in Montgomery.

Mayor Marler announced that Planning Commission Chairman, Ray Bickley, brought recommendations to add R1.3 to zoning and change Tod's Wrecker Service on Hwy 431 from C-1 to M-1. A motion was made by Spurling and a second by Williams, Jr. The council voted as follows to approve:
