

COUNCIL CHAMBERS

April 5, 2016

TIME: 6:00PM

The Council of the City of Headland was called to order in the City Hall on April 5, 2016 with the following members present: Ray Marler, Mayor; Councilmembers: James Williams, Jr., Jody Singleton, Michael Roland, Joe Falkner, and Kendrick Spurling.

Upon a motion by Roland and a second by Falkner, the Council voted to approve the minutes of the previous meeting as follows:

Motion carried unanimously.

Public Comments:

Jason Singletary, Water Superintendent, gave an update on the ADEM Conference he attended in Mobile. Singletary advised the council that this is our year for Lead & Copper testing, he will be bringing prices on automatic flush hydrants, and the water tank was inspected and needs painting. He also advised the council that that our toxicity level testing fails every year. It was also discussed that we need to look at dredging two cells of our South Lagoon.

Singletary advised that Sweetwater has been paved and the ballparks are open.

Mayor Marler stated that a voting delegate, 1st and 2nd alternate needed to be selected for the League Convention.

Upon a motion by Singleton to nominate Spurling as the delegate, Roland as the 1st alternate and Singleton as the 2nd alternate and a second by Williams, Jr. the council voted as follows to approve:

Fire Chief, Glenn Temples, requested permission to send Captain Chad Hughes and Matt Hatcher to Pyro Training in Caryville, TN on April 23rd and 24th. There is no fee for the class; the city's expenses would be lodging, travel and Overtime Expense to cover their shifts.

Chief Temples also thanked Jason Singletary and his crew for replacing the fire hydrant in front of the Methodist Church.

Chief Temples stated they are in the process of applying for another ADM Grant through John Sheppard.

Chief Temples introduced Brett Buchanan with Stryker EMS Equipment. Mayor Marler stated a demonstration on a stretcher would be held by Buchanan after the meeting.

Mayor Marler asked the council to review the March 2016 paid bills.
