

COUNCIL CHAMBERS

July 5, 2016

The Council of the City of Headland was called to order in the City Hall on July 5, 2016 with the following members present: Ray Marler, Mayor; Councilmembers: James Williams, Jr., Jody Singleton, Joe Falkner and Kendrick Spurling. Councilman Michael Roland was not present.

Upon a motion by Singleton and a second by Falkner, the Council voted to approve the minutes of the previous meeting as follows:

Public Comments:

Roger Mixson with the Headland Municipal Airport reported they sold over a \$1,000 in Jet A Fuel last week.

The council was presented an introduction of a rezone request for a property located on the corner of Log Lane and Hwy 134. The request is to change the rezone from OL to R1.2. This request was approved at the recent Planning Commission Meeting and will be brought forth at the next council meeting for a vote.

Council was presented with June Bills. Upon a motion by Singleton and a second by Spurling, the Council voted as follows to approved the paid bills:

Councilman Williams, Jr. also requested the speed bumps on Cable Street and MLK Drive need to be restriped.
